

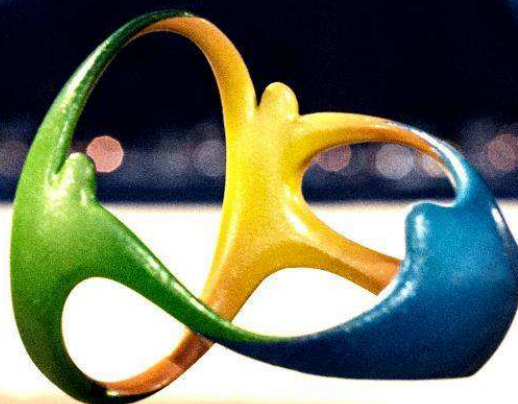

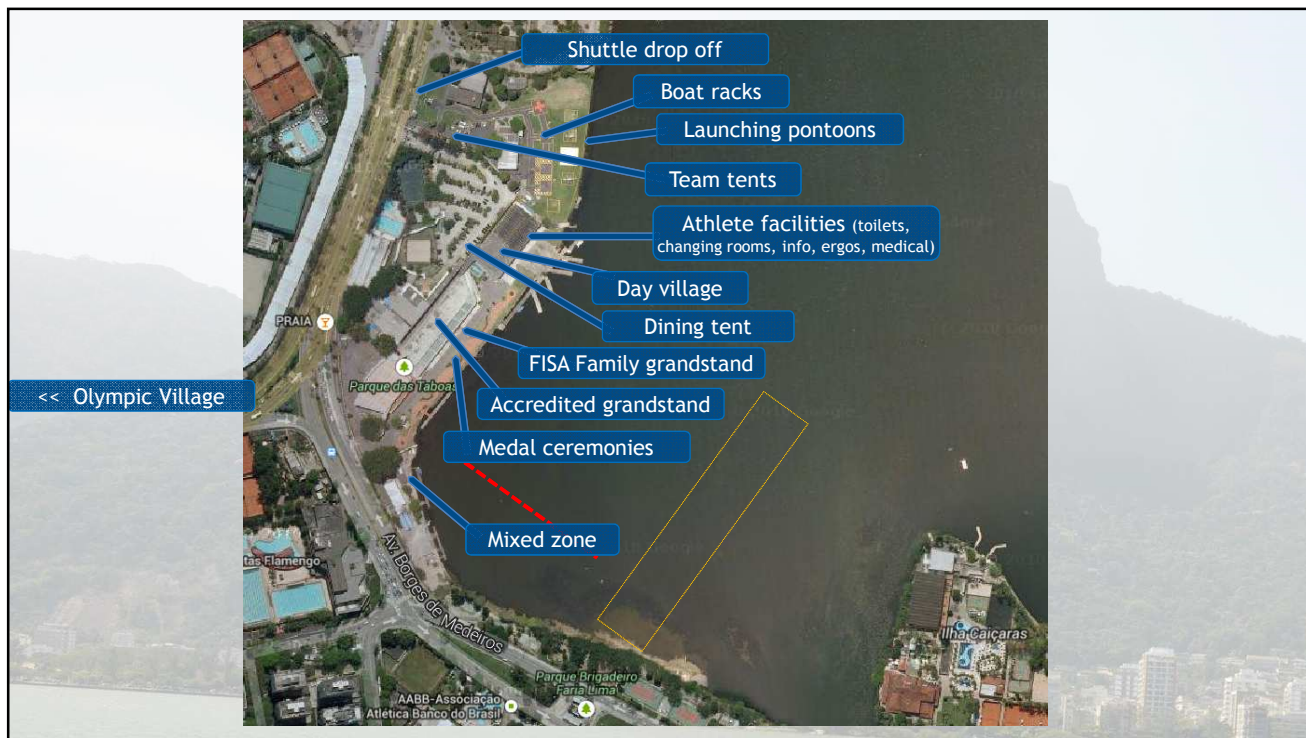
LAGOA RODRIGO DE FREITAS

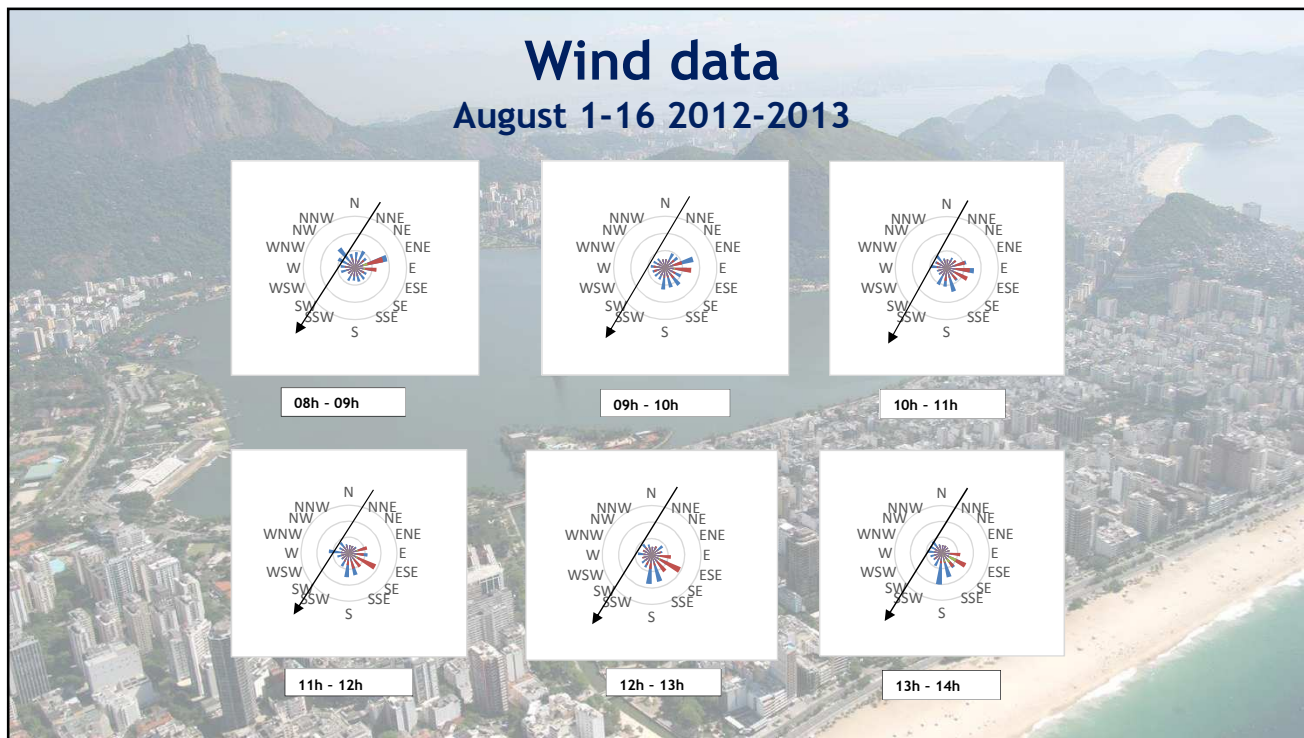

Transport

- Estimated travel time from Olympic Village to Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas : 34 minutes excluding security clearance (estimated at 3 minutes for TA buses)
- Olympic lane network - extends up to athlete shuttle drop off
- Accessible buses will be provided
- Renovation of suburban railway network and underground network expansion
- At Games time, public transport will be free of charge for accredited clients and ticket holders





Freight Support

- ❑ Rio 2016 will ship boats and oars from two designated hubs in Europe
- ❑ Containers must be delivered to these hubs on specified dates (different dates and shipments for Olympic and Paralympic)
- ❑ NOCs that do not choose to use the Rio 2016 system will be responsible for their own freight (including costs)
- ❑ Freight Manual (1st draft) in Dec 2014

Boat transport

- Boat shipping to and from the venue is the responsibility of the NF
- Import tax exemption applies under Temporary Admission system - but equipment must leave the country!
- Compulsory to use a Brazilian freight forwarder
- Delivery window will be confirmed
